Terms of Service & Privacy Policy

Version 1.0 — 12 March 2026

Preamble

BikerPlay is an iOS application developed by Julien LEMPEREUR (hereinafter "the Developer"), designed to accompany motorcyclists, cyclists and motorists during their rides. It offers a connected dashboard integrating navigation, music, safety and ride tracking.

These Terms of Service and Privacy Policy constitute a contract between the user (hereinafter "you") and the Developer. By downloading and using BikerPlay, you accept all of these terms.

⚠ SAFETY WARNING — *BikerPlay is designed to be used with a phone mount fixed to your vehicle. Never use the app by hand while driving. Always stay focused on the road. The Developer declines all responsibility in case of accident linked to inappropriate use of the application.*

Article 1 — Purpose and Scope

These Terms govern the use of the BikerPlay mobile application available on Apple's App Store. They apply to any person downloading, installing or using the application, regardless of their geographical location.

Article 2 — Feature Description

2.1 Navigation Features

- Real-time GPS position display on map (MapKit)
- Route calculation to a destination (Apple Maps / MKDirections)
- Speed limit display on current road (Overpass API / OpenStreetMap)
- Automatic GPS ride recording
- Ride history with statistics (distance, duration, speed)

2.2 Music Features

- Apple Music playback control (MusicKit)
- Synchronised lyrics display (IrcLib.net)
- CarPlay support for music playback (optional)

2.3 Safety Features

- SOS button opening the phone app to a configured emergency number
- Location sharing by SMS

- Crash detection via accelerometer with automatic SMS alert (optional)
- Pre-departure verification checklist

2.4 Health & Data Tracking

- Heart rate display via Apple Watch and HealthKit (optional)
- Vehicle expense tracking (fuel, maintenance)
- Nearby fuel prices (French government open data API)

Article 3 — Access and Use Conditions

3.1 Technical Requirements

- iPhone running iOS 16.0 or later
- Internet access for real-time features
- Active Apple Music subscription for music features
- Paired Apple Watch for heart rate monitoring (optional)

3.2 Authorised Use

The app is intended for personal, non-commercial use. You agree to:

- Use BikerPlay only in a lawful manner compliant with road regulations in your country
- Not attempt to bypass the application's security measures
- Not use the app by hand while driving
- Verify the relevance of displayed information before relying on it

3.3 User Responsibility

The user is solely responsible for their use of the application while driving. BikerPlay is an assistance tool — it does not replace the driver's judgement, official road signs, or highway code.

Article 4 — Privacy Policy & Personal Data

BikerPlay is designed with data minimisation in mind (Privacy by Design). No personal data is collected, stored or transmitted to the Developer or third parties for commercial purposes.

4.1 Data Stored Locally on Your Device

- Recorded GPS rides (coordinates, speed, timestamps)
- App settings (preferences, pilot name, vehicle)
- Favourite contacts in the Phone tab
- Vehicle expenses (fuel, maintenance)
- Custom pre-departure checklist

This data never leaves your device via BikerPlay and is deleted upon uninstalling the application.

4.2 Data Transmitted to Third-Party Services

- Open-Meteo (open-meteo.com) — Weather: your approximate GPS location is sent. No personal data collected.
- Overpass API / OpenStreetMap — Speed limits: your GPS position. Data under ODbL licence.
- Irclib.net — Song lyrics: current song title and artist only.
- French Government Open Data — Fuel prices: your GPS position. Public API, no personal data.

None of these services receive your name, Apple ID, email address or any other personally identifying data.

4.3 System Permissions Requested

- Location (Always / When In Use) — GPS tracking during rides
- Music Library — Apple Music playback via MusicKit
- Contacts — Selecting emergency and favourite contacts
- Health (read only) — Heart rate from Apple Watch via HealthKit
- Motion & Fitness — Crash detection via accelerometer

Each permission is requested the first time the corresponding feature is used. You may revoke these permissions at any time in iOS Settings.

4.4 Your GDPR Rights

- Right of access: all your data is local on your device
- Right of rectification: editable in the application settings
- Right to erasure: uninstall the application to delete all your data
- Right to portability: rides are exportable in standard GPX format

Article 5 — Intellectual Property

The BikerPlay application, its source code, design, icons and content are the exclusive property of the Developer. Any reproduction, modification, distribution or commercial exploitation without prior written authorisation is strictly prohibited.

BikerPlay uses third-party components under open-source licences: MapKit and MusicKit (Apple Inc.), OpenStreetMap (ODbL licence), Open-Meteo (CC BY 4.0 licence).

Article 6 — Limitation of Liability

6.1 Accuracy of Information

BikerPlay displays real-time data from third-party services. The Developer does not guarantee the accuracy, completeness or availability of this information, provided for informational purposes only.

*Speed limits displayed come from the OpenStreetMap database and may not be up to date.
Always comply with official road signs.*

6.2 Crash Detection Feature

Crash detection is an experimental feature based on the iPhone accelerometer. It may generate false alerts or fail to detect certain accidents. It does not replace a certified safety device.

6.3 Liability Exclusion

To the extent permitted by applicable law, the Developer shall not be liable for any direct or indirect damage resulting from the use of BikerPlay, including in the event of a road accident, data loss or third-party service malfunction.

Article 7 — SOS and Crash Detection Features

These features are entirely optional and disabled by default. By enabling them, you acknowledge:

- Having configured valid contact numbers and obtained their consent to receive SMS alerts
- That SMS sending uses the iOS Messages app — BikerPlay does not send SMS directly
- That these features do not replace official emergency services (112)
- That in a real emergency, you should always call 112

Article 8 — Updates and Changes to Terms

The Developer reserves the right to modify these Terms at any time. Changes take effect upon publication in an application update. Continued use of BikerPlay after modification constitutes acceptance of the new terms.

Article 9 — Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by French law. In case of dispute, and failing amicable resolution, the competent courts are those of the Developer's registered address.
